Buttonbush *Cephalanthus occidentalis*

Glossy green leaves and fragrant round flower clusters, perfect for a bioswale.



Light: Full sun, part shade

Soil Moisture: Wet Height: 6-12 feet

Habit: Shrub Flower: White

Bloom Time: Summer

Pollinators: Bees, butterflies, flies,

wasps

Note: Attracts over 24 species of birds, including robin, kingbird, and

towhee.
